This archaeological project was undertaken as part of the design and construction of a new retention wall complex on the eastern end of Old Town.

Chronicle Heritage worked with Al-Bawani Construction Company, who conducted the wall construction and foundation excavation for the Royal Commission for AlUla (RCU). The project entailed the monitoring of machinery conducting ground reduction and the excavation and documentation of subsurface archaeology.

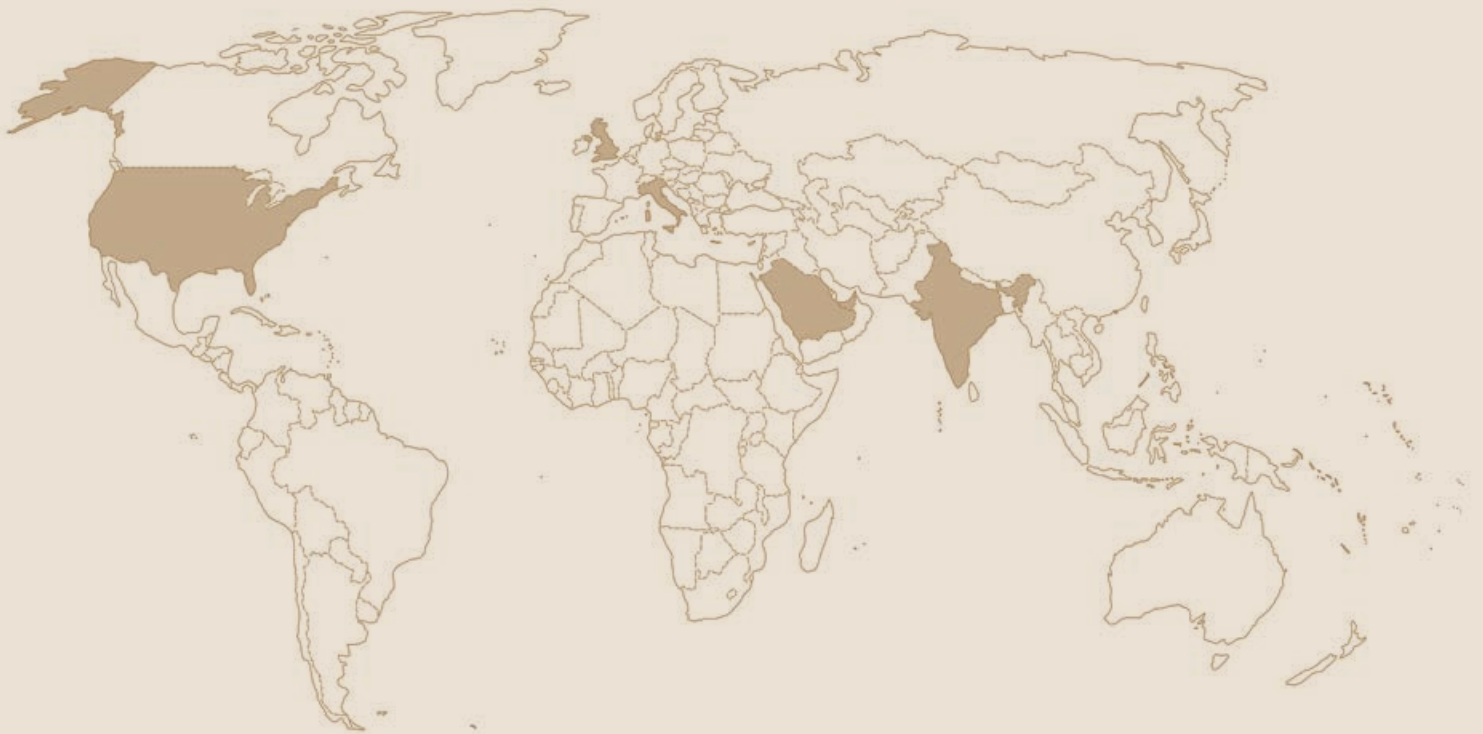
The project revealed at least three phases of occupation and the discovery of the City Wall, buildings, and thoroughfares leading from Old Town to the Oasis below.
