



# PROJECT SECURE HERITAGE IMPACT ASSESSMENT (HIA)

Chronicle Heritage is currently undertaking a series of Heritage Impact Assessments (HIA) on 39 heritage assets in AlUla County ahead of their proposed protection. The heritage assets include Hejaz Railway Stations, Ottoman Period castles and forts, rock art sites, tombs, and settlement sites.

Chronicle Heritage worked with the project team to find solutions to protect the sites while also balancing the visitor experience and future activations and development.

The project was approached in two phases; Phase 1 addresses the 22 priority sites and Phase 2 addresses the remaining 17 sites.

For each phase, Chronicle Heritage produced a HIA Scoping Statement, providing updated field assessments and descriptions, provisional recommendations for the fence lines and security measures, and assessing the impact of the proposed fencing works on the heritage assets and their setting at each site.

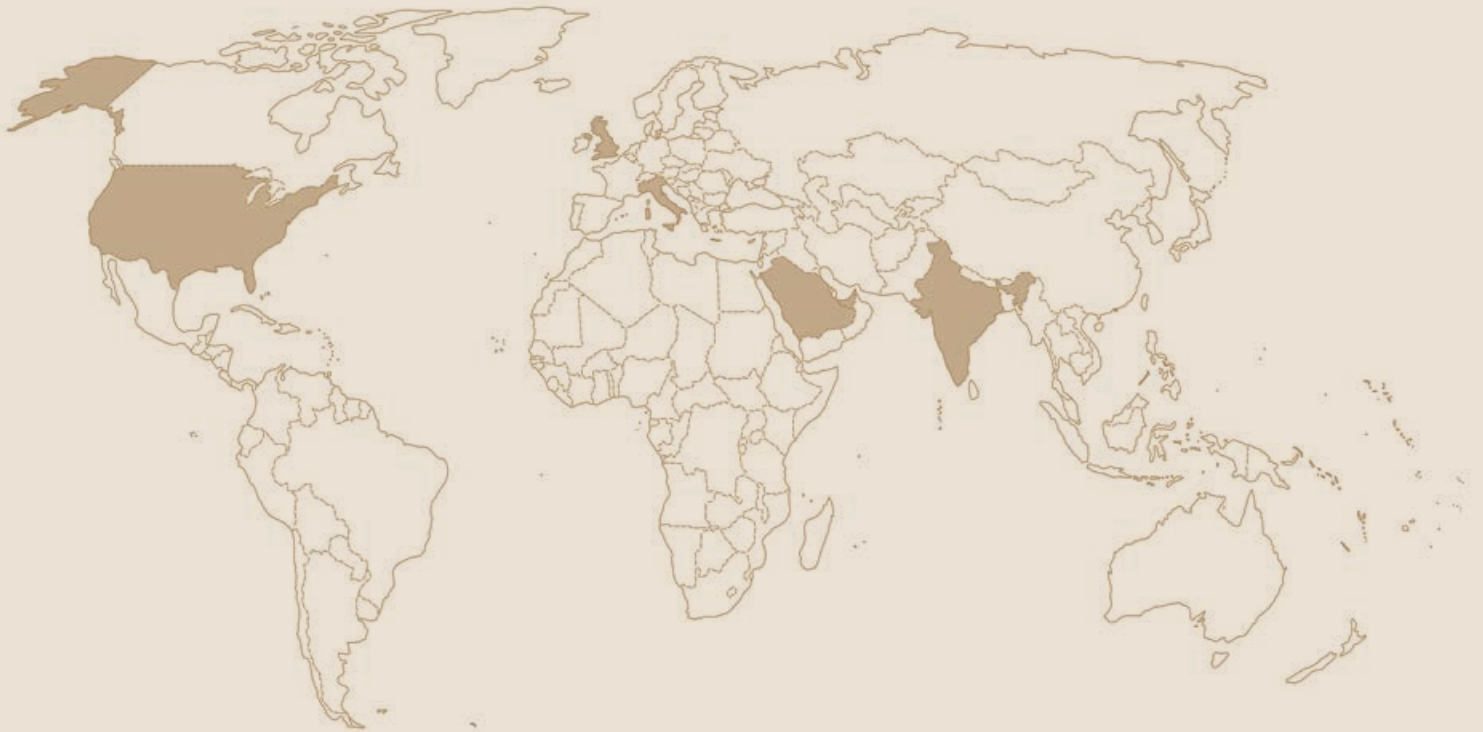
Finally, Chronicle Heritage also conducted archaeological monitoring for the installation of the fences and other security measures as recommended to best protect the heritage assets.
